

Professional Development Requirements for Licensure using the IDEAS Portal



Arkansas licensure requires documentation of completion of the following professional development modules which are obtained through the Arkansas IDEAS Portal:

- Family and Community Engagement;
- Child maltreatment training;
- Teen suicide awareness and prevention;
- Bullying prevention;
- Human trafficking awareness;
- Code of Ethics training.
