

What you need to know about....

Childhood Education (B.S.E.)

4 Year program track

Candidates in the Elementary Education Program earn a Bachelor of Science in Education and are eligible for an Arkansas K-6 teaching license in 4 years.



Future graduate degrees wide open

Program completers are eligible to pursue graduate degrees focused on specific areas of interest or other specialized fields of study.



Field experiences include a full year of student teaching

Students complete field experiences during their undergraduate program of study. With the final year of classes, students complete a full year of student teaching in a local NW Arkansas school district. (~900 hrs.)



K-6 Grade Level License

Upon completion of the B.S.E. students are eligible for an Arkansas license in Elementary Education, grades K-6.



Study Abroad

Candidates are eligible to participate in programs offered through Study Abroad and International Exchange. This includes opportunities before internship and faculty-led out-of-area placements during internship year.
